S U M M E R S E R I E S JUNE 26-29. 2025 TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) There is no new inning after 2 hours and 10 minutes in all games, except the June 29th semi-final and championship games.
- 2) There is an 8 run rule after 5 innings, a 12 run rule after 4 innings in all games and a 20 run rule in all games, except the June 29th championship game, unless otherwise agreed upon by both coaches of the championship game and the umpires during the pre-game umpire meeting.
- 3) There is a pro DH rule where the pitcher is the only position that can be DHed for.
- 4) There are no pitch count or inning limits for the PSS. Coaches will be expected to put player safety above all else when it comes to arm care and overuse.
- 5) Each team is allowed to use one Extra Hitter (EH) per game. Extra hitter will remain in that position, unless substituted for by another hitter. The EH can rotate onto the field defensively as well.
- 6) Players cannot double roster to play on multiple teams within the event. Should an emergency arise that would force the need of an additional player to be added from another team a request can be made, but would need to be done prior to the game and agreed upon by both teams and the tournament director.
- 7) A slide and avoid rule will be enforced. Runner must be within arm's length of the base.
- 8) The home team book is the official game book.
- 9) Coaches do not have to wear helmets.
- 10) Courtesy runners are allowed for catchers and pitchers only, but not mandatory.
- 11) There is no re-entry for a player removed from the lineup.
- 12) There are -3 restrictions for all bats and must be BBCOR Certified. All non -3 bats will be excluded from tournament competition.
- 13) This is a 17-under tournament. Eligible players must have been born on or after April 1, 2007. Any player born before this date is not eligible. Please be prepared to show verification of player age if questioned. Ineligible players participating in tournament games will result in forfeiture of those games participated in.
- 14) The American League Big Book covers all rules not discussed here.
- 15) Absolutely NO sunflower seeds are allowed on the field or in the dugout at WSU, per WSU Athletic Department policy. A \$50.00 fee will be imposed on the spot if sunflower seeds are found on the field or in the dugout. The fee must be paid before the next game is to be played by the offending team. No warning is necessary to impose fee.
- 16)Team listed first for each pool play game is home team and will occupy third base dugout. If playing the first game of a DH, please stay in the same dugout even if home/visitor switch. The LC Cubs will have the 3rd base dugout for all their games regardless of home and away or back to back game if they choose.
- 17) The top seeds from each pool will advance to Sunday's semi-final match ups. Check the schedule to see which time your bracket is set to play. Home team will be determined by overall record first and then follow the tie breakers to determine home and away.

- 18) Tie breakers are in the following order:
 - a) Head to head
 - b) Least runs allowed
 - c) Most runs scored
 - d) Coin flip

*In the case of a 3 way tie where head to head cannot determine a winner, we will then follow the tie breaker order until a winner is determined. Once a winner is determined, the order of the 2 remaining teams will then be determined by returning to head to head.

TOURNAMENT EXTRAS

- Weather or other extenuating circumstances, such as smoke, that occur during tournament play that limit the number of games played will determine the following refund:
 - 1 game played = 50% refund
 - 2 games or more played = no refund
- * Cages can be utilized at Colfax's McDonald Park, but not at WSU. Each team will have access to a cage on their respective sides. If our local youth teams are using the softball cages, the main cage schedule will go as follows; home team 1:15 mins prior to the games start time and the away team :45 mins prior to the games start time. The same cage schedule will be used for any games played at Pullman High Schools, Quann Field. LCSC may have available indoor cages out passed the right field wall and the schedule for that is TBD. Wiffle balls will be needed at Clearwater Fields as they do not have cages. Moscow SDC Playfields has two cages, one on each side of the main field. Teams can access those on their respective sides.
- We will follow all health guidelines in place by the state of Washington, Whitman County and Washington State University as well as the state of Idaho, Nez Perce County and Lewis and Clark State College.
- NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED AT WSU or WSU's Valley Road Playfields. This goes for any part of the facility. Metal spikes can be worn at LCSC and Colfax, but not WSU.
- There are no seeds allowed at WSU's Bailey Brayton, WSU Valley Playfields or LCSC's Harris Field. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Each team will provided a box of baseballs upon arriving at the tournament. Any additional new baseballs will be provided by the team if you run out of the courtesy box of balls from the PSS.
- There are no gate fees for the 2025 Palouse Summer Series. All guidelines for fans attending the game will be determined by each fields governing body and will strictly follow our states guidelines at the minimum.
- Alcohol and tobacco products are not allowed at any of the PSS sites and Dogs are not allowed at WSU's Bailey-Brayton Field
- Upon arrival each tournament may have game awards, prizes, homerun coupons, etc. The gates
 and site supervisors will handle distribution of those prizes, but make sure coaches and parents
 are also communicating as a reminder. We want to make sure those coupons are handed out.

INCLEMENT WEATHER OUTLINE

- The tournament director will make the ultimate decision to delay, reschedule, or cancel any tournament games, but not without consultation from any or all of the following: coaches from both teams, umpires, and site management personnel. Please keep in mind that it is in the best interest of all involved that the maximum number of tournament games is completed.
- In the event of inclement weather on any one of the tournament days, the schedule may be altered so that maximum games are played for each team as evenly as possible, with respect to the entire tournament field.
- In the event that inclement weather does cancel games before championship Sunday, the team(s) with the best record out of the round robin division play will be placed in the championship bracket. In the event that more than one team has the same record in round robin division play, the team(s) with the largest run differential will be placed in the championship bracket.
- The goal of the tournament is to ensure that the maximum number of tournament games are completed evenly by all teams and a champion is crowned on championship Sunday. The tournament director's decisions will reflect this premise.




